Famous Burial Anthony Kenny All Sgints



• Buried 04/21/1919

Anthony Kenny, buried in our very own All Saints Catholic Cemetery in Braddock, PA, was the owner of the land that the amusement park Kennywood now sits on. This tree-filled land affectionately called "Kenny's Grove" was a popular picnic spot for Pittsburghers after the time of the Civil War.

In 1898, the Monongahela Street Railways Company leased the land from Kenny to build a trolley park. A year later, a carousel, casino hall, and dance pavilion were built. Kennywood was then born from Anthony Kenny's humble picnic destination.
